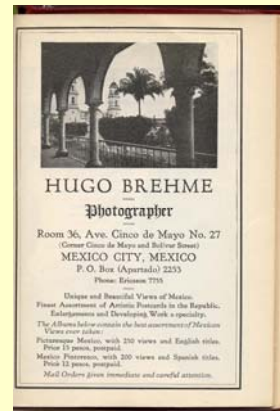
## Abstract

- Susan Toomey Frost will give a brief overview of the postcards produced by Hugo Brehme (born 1882 in Eisenach, Germany). Brehme, who first came to Mexico in 1905, became a Mexican citizen a few years before his death in 1954.
- The postcards of Hugo Brehme, including those images taken by his son Arno, generally depict landscapes, archaeological sites, and buildings and monuments that found great appeal among tourists. Frost's presentation, however, will focus on the human subjects of less widely distributed postcards of the Brehme Studio.
